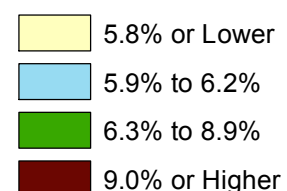
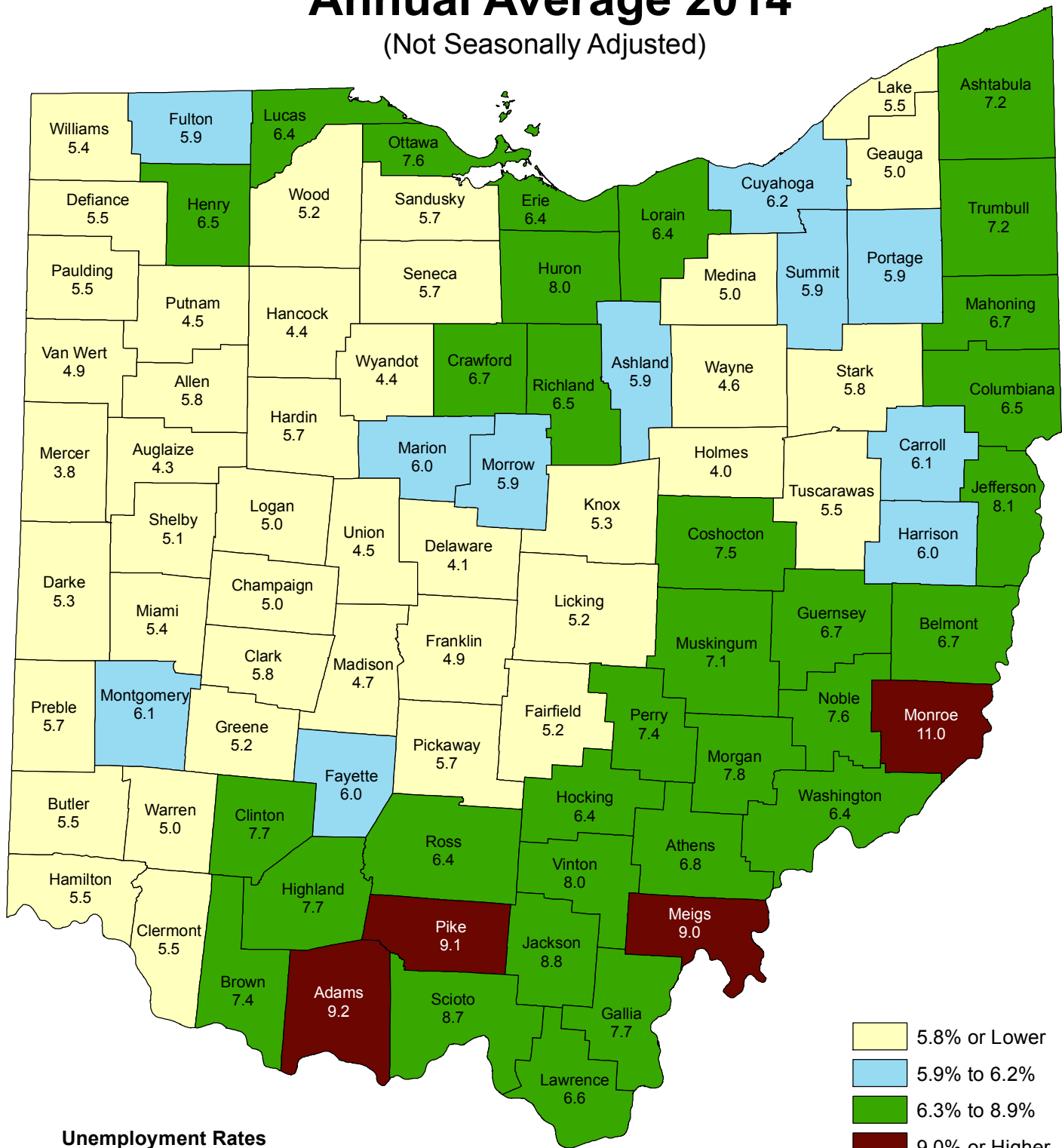


Ohio Unemployment Rates
