

Establishment Closures in Ohio, 2012

In 2012, there were 18 closures of establishments with 50 or more employees identified by the Mass Layoff Statistics (MLS) program. The 18 closures resulted in 3,638 separations. Retail trade accounted for 37.2 percent of separations, followed by wholesale trade with 21.3 percent and manufacturing with 17.6 percent. Closures represented 6.8 percent of total mass layoff events (266) and 8.6 percent of total separations (42,230).

Overall, 10 of the 88 counties statewide experienced establishment closures as defined by the MLS Program. Closures in Butler and Hamilton Counties included more than 250 separations each.
