

Mass Layoff Statistics 1st Quarter 1999

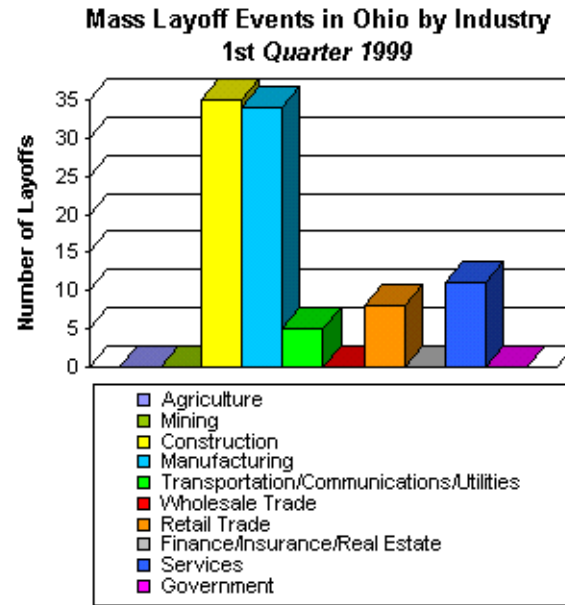
During the period January through March 1999, there were 98 mass layoff events in Ohio resulting in 12,551 separations.

Mass Layoff Events by Industry

Thirty-six percent of the total number of mass layoff events occurred in Construction, representing 33% of all separations. Manufacturing facilities accounted for 35% of all mass layoff events and 35% of all separations.

Mass Layoff Events by Primary Reason

Events that were seasonal in nature accounted for 41% of all mass layoffs and 45% of all separations. Contract completion was responsible for 19% of total mass layoffs and 21% of workers separated. Included in the 98 mass layoffs for Ohio were 5 actual establishment closures with 877 separations.
