

Mass Layoff Statistics 2nd Quarter 1999

During the period April through June 1999, there were 77 mass layoff events in Ohio resulting in 12,747 separations.

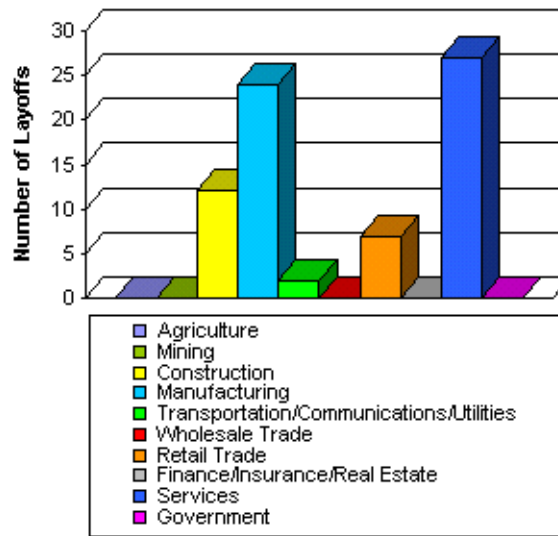
Mass Layoff Events by Industry

Thirty-five percent of the total number of mass layoff events occurred in Services, representing 32% of all separations. Manufacturing facilities accounted for 31% of all mass layoff events and 35% of all separations.

Mass Layoff Events by Primary Reason

Events that were seasonal in nature accounted for 32% of all mass layoffs and 33% of all separations. Contract completion was responsible for 26% of total mass layoffs and 22% of workers separated. Included in the 77 mass layoffs for Ohio were 13 actual establishment closures with 1,587 separations.
