

Mass Layoff Statistics 3rd Quarter 1999

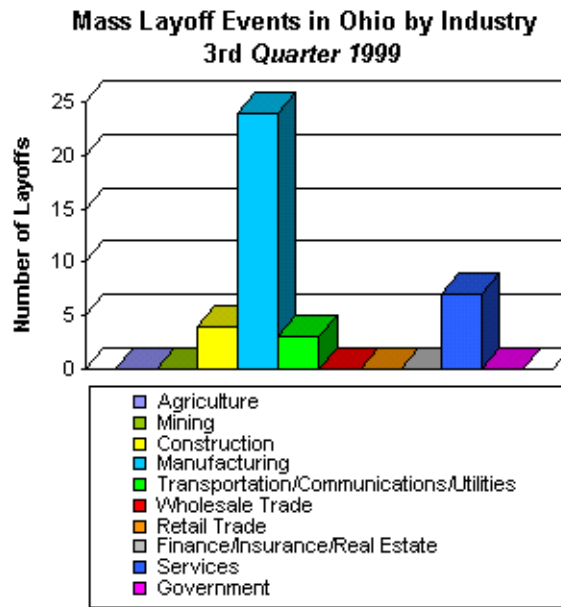
During the period July through September 1999, there were 43 mass layoff events in Ohio resulting in 6,584 separations.

Mass Layoff Events by Industry

Manufacturing facilities accounted for 56% of all mass layoff events and 50% of all separations. Sixteen percent of the total number of mass layoff events occurred in Services, representing 17% of all separations.

Mass Layoff Events by Primary Reason

Reorganization was responsible for 33% of total mass layoffs and 31% of workers separated. Events that were due to contract completion accounted for 19% of all mass layoffs and 20% of all separations. Included in the 43 mass layoffs for Ohio were 10 actual establishment closures with 1,072 separations.
