

## Mass Layoff Statistics 4th Quarter 2000

During the period October through December 2000, there were 130 mass layoff events in Ohio, an increase of 50 events over fourth quarter 1999. This resulted in 24,183 separations, an over the year increase of 7,491 from the fourth quarter 1999 total of 16,692 separations.

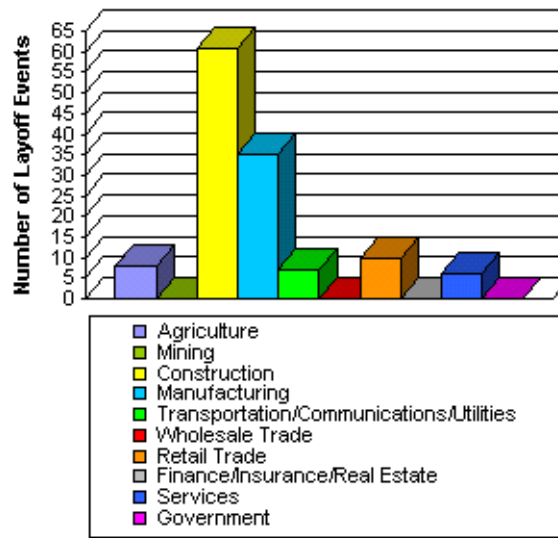
### Mass Layoff Events by Industry

Forty-seven percent of the total number of mass layoff events occurred in Construction, representing 39% of all separations. Manufacturing facilities accounted for 27% of all mass layoff events and 40% of all separations.

## Mass Layoff Events by Primary Reason

Events that were seasonal in nature accounted for 51% of all mass layoffs and 40% of all separations. Slack Work was responsible for 21% of total mass layoffs and 28% of workers separated. Included in the 130 mass layoffs for Ohio were 9 actual establishment closures with 839 separations.
