

## Mass Layoff Statistics 1st Quarter 2003

During the period January through March 2003, there were 63 mass layoff events in Ohio, a decrease of 21 events from the First Quarter of 2002. This resulted in 6,339 separations, an over the year decrease of 5,984 from the First Quarter 2002 total of 12,323 separations.

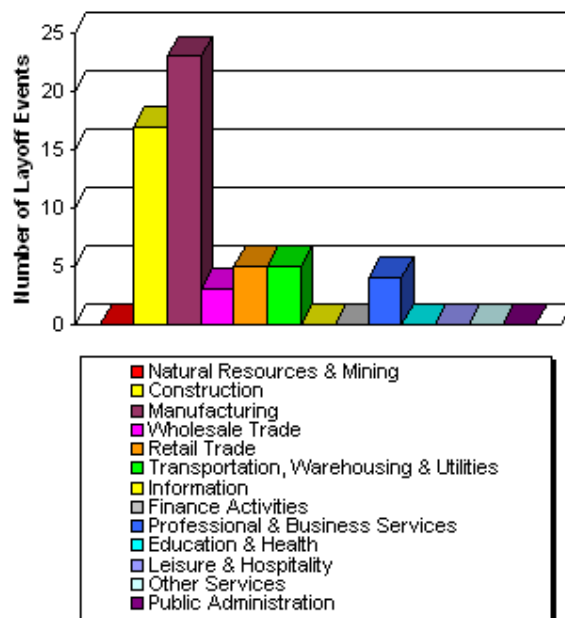
### Mass Layoff Events by Industry

Thirty-seven percent of the total number of mass layoff events occurred in manufacturing, representing 33% of all separations. Construction accounted for 27% of all mass layoff events and 26% of all separations. Transportation, Warehousing and Utilities along with Retail Trade claimed 8% of the mass layoffs events with 13% and 10% of all separations respectfully.

## Mass Layoff Events by Primary Reason

Contract completed, was responsible for 29% of total mass layoffs and 28% of workers separated. Company Reorganization accounted for 25% of all mass layoffs and 27% of all separations. Included in the 63 mass layoffs for Ohio were 16 actual establishment closures with 992 separations. In comparison, there were 16 closures with 2,810 separations in the 4th quarter 2002.
