

## Mass Layoff Events in Ohio 4th Quarter 2010

During the period October through December 2010, there were 105 mass layoff events in Ohio, a increase of 8 events from the 4th Quarter of 2009. This resulted in 15,066 separations, a decrease of 2,174 from the 4th Quarter 2009 total of 17,240 separations. Included in the 105 events were 3 establishment closures/partial closures of single or multiple worksites with 470 separations. This compares to 6 establishment closures and 755 separations from a year ago.

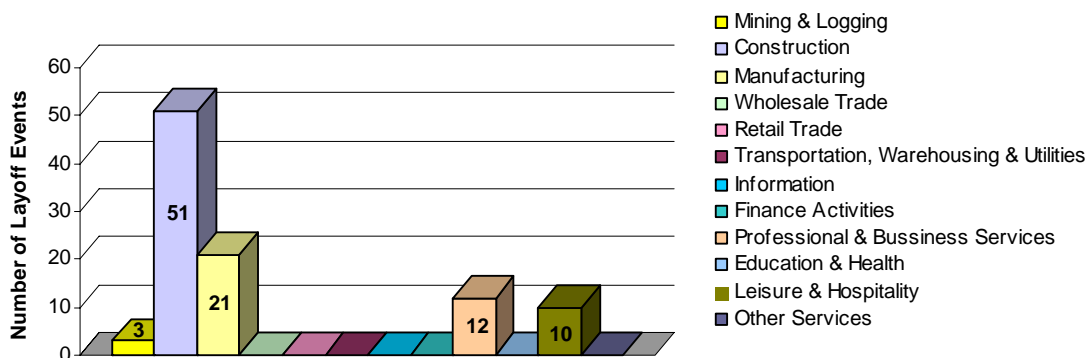
### Events by Industry

Construction out paced all with 49% of the total number of mass layoff events and 41% of all separations. Manufacturing followed with 20% of the total events and represented 32% of all separations.

4th Quarter 2010**

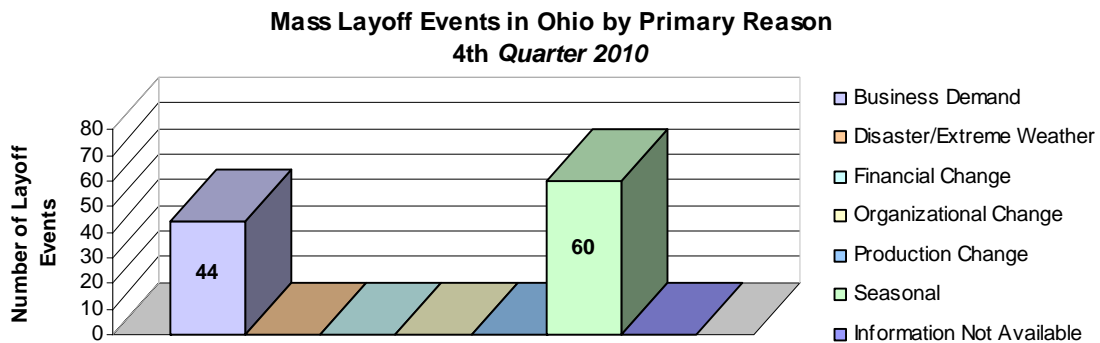


## Events by Primary Reason

Seasonal events was responsible for 58% of all mass layoffs and 45% of all separations. Business Demand accounted for 42% of all mass layoffs and 55% of all separations.
