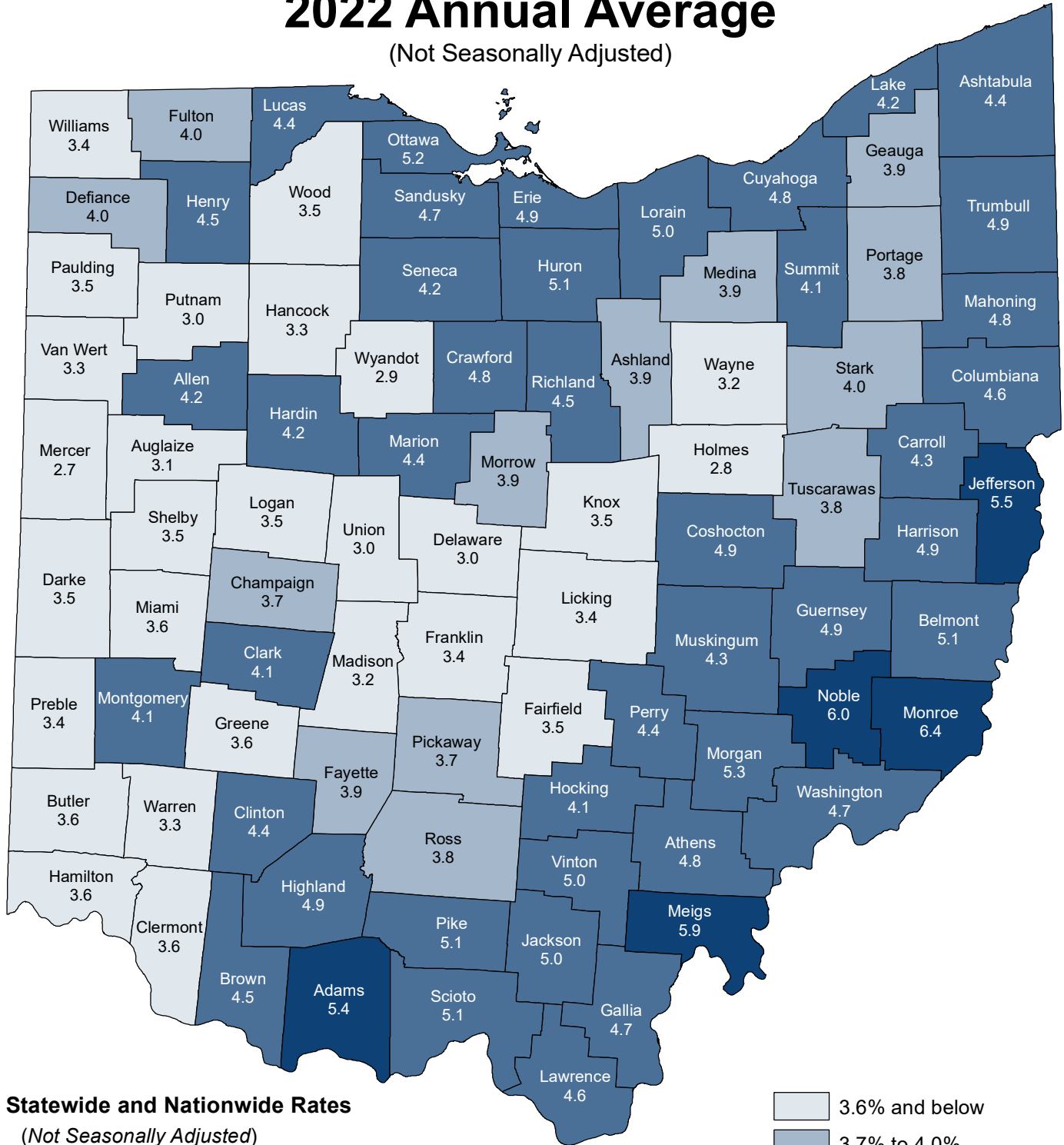


Ohio Unemployment Rates 2022 Annual Average

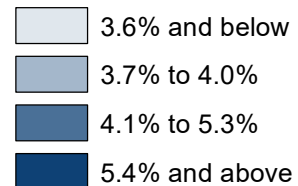
