

Snapshot of Ohio Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

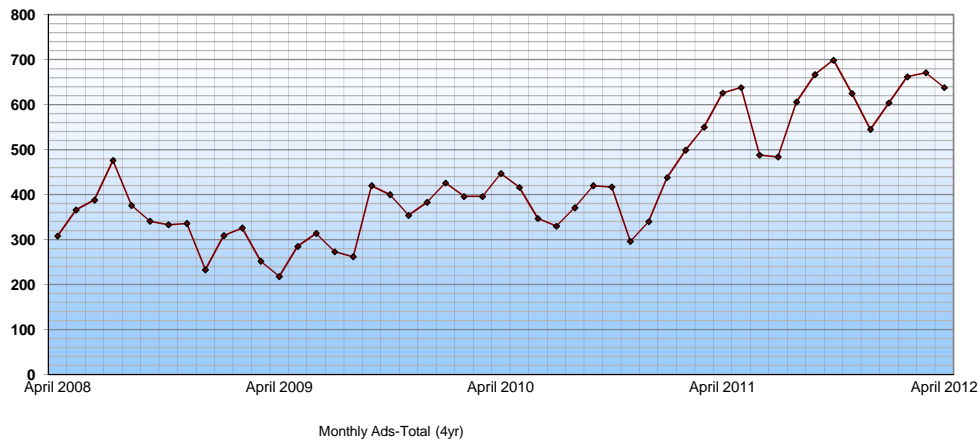

Summary

For the last 30-day reporting period (March 14 - April 13), **638** Help Wanted OnLine® (HWOL) ads were posted for internships, according to data from The Conference Board. There was a decrease of 33 from the previous reporting period. Compared to the same time period a year ago, this reflected an increase of 12 ads. In addition, the graph below shows monthly trends of new internship ads posted through April 13, 2012.
