

Snapshot of Ohio Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

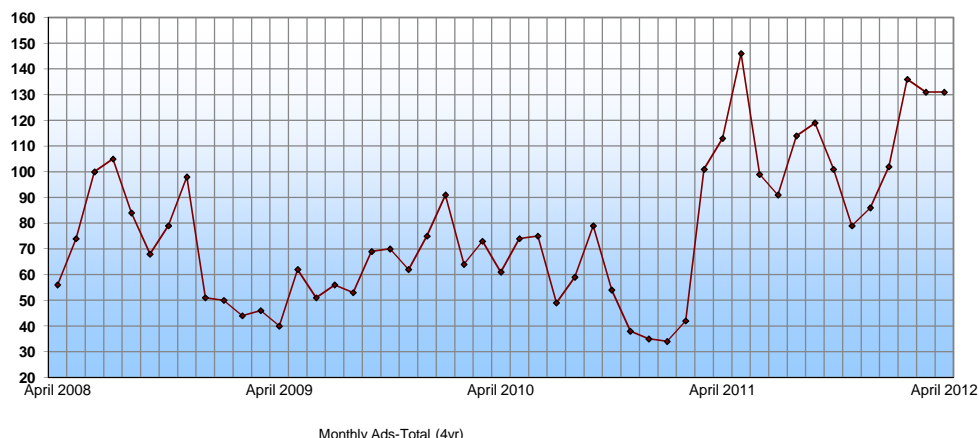

Summary

For the last 30-day reporting period (March 14 - April 13), **131** Help Wanted OnLine® (HWOL) ads were posted for internships, according to data from The Conference Board. There was no change from the previous reporting period. Compared to the same time period a year ago, this reflects an increase of 18 ads. In addition, the graph below reflects monthly trends of new internship ads posted through April 13, 2012.
