

# Snapshot of Ohio Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

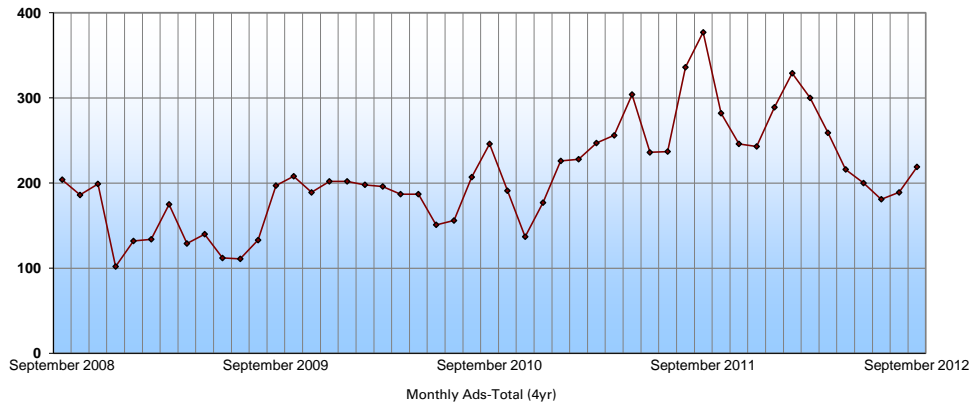

## Summary

For the monthly reporting period, **189** Help Wanted OnLine® (HWOL) ads were posted for internships, according to data from The Conference Board. This is an increase of 30 ads from the previous reporting period. Compared to the same time period a year ago, this reflects a decrease of 158 ads. In addition, the graph below reflects monthly trends of new internship ads posted through September 30, 2012.
