

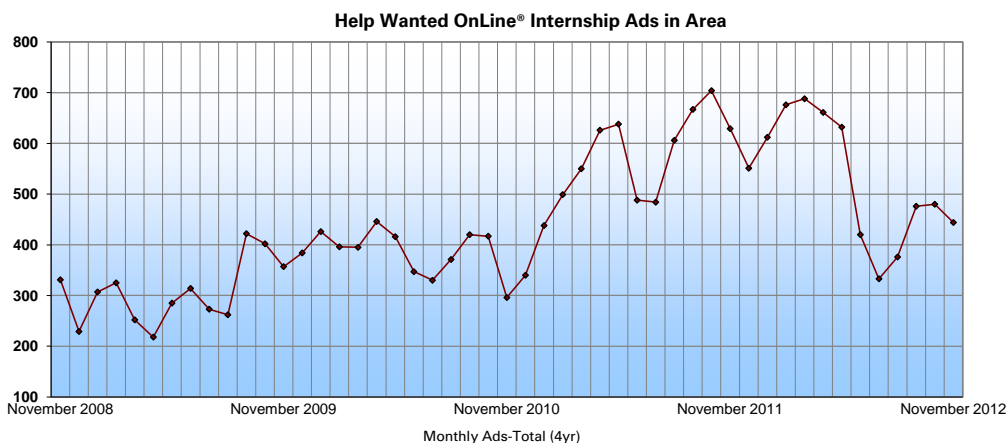
Snapshot of Ohio Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

Summary

For the monthly reporting period, **444** Help Wanted OnLine® (HWOL) ads were posted for internships, according to data from The Conference Board. This reflects a decrease of 36 ads from the previous reporting period. Compared to the same time period a year ago, this reflected a decrease of 185 ads. In addition, the graph below shows monthly trends of new internship ads posted through November 30, 2012.
