

Snapshot of Ohio Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

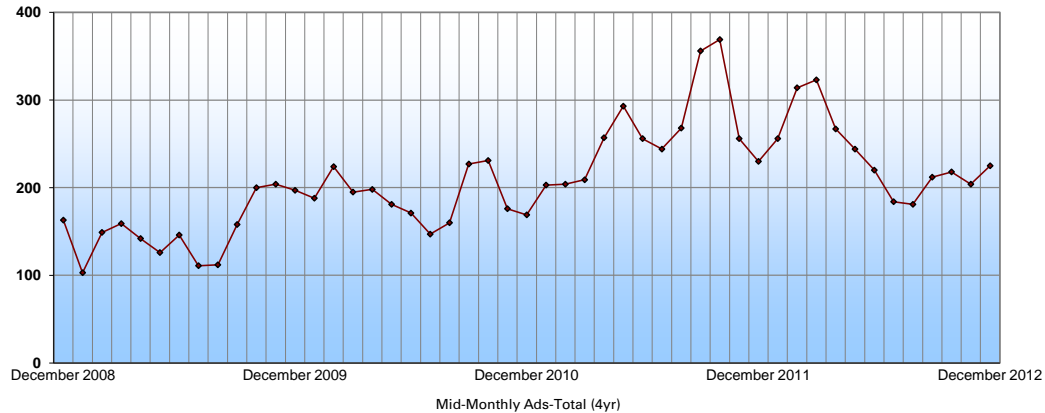

Summary

For the last 30-day Conference Board reporting period (November 14, 2012 - December 13, 2012) there were 225 Help Wanted OnLine® (HWOL) ads posted for internships, according to data from The Conference Board. This is an increase of 21 ads from the previous reporting period. Compared to the same time period a year ago, this reflects a decrease of 5 ads. In addition, the graph below reflects monthly trends of new internship ads posted through December 13, 2012.
