

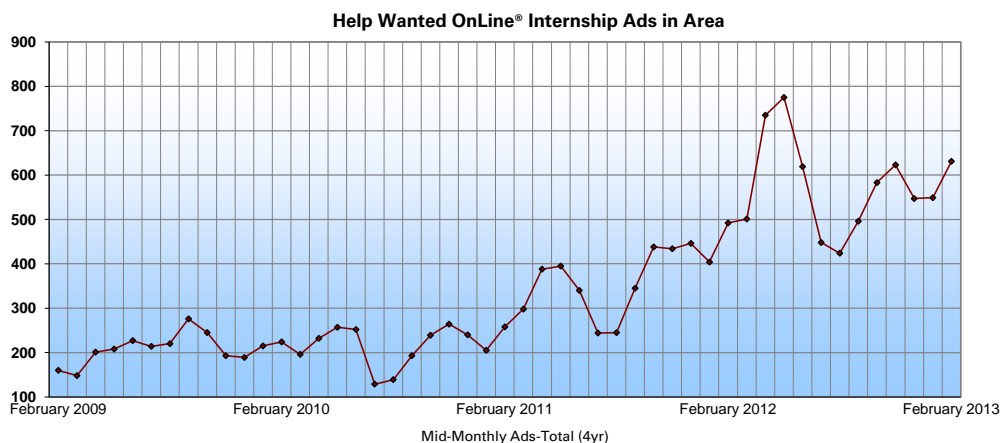
Snapshot of Ohio Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

February 2013

Summary

For the last 30-day Conference Board reporting period (January 14, 2013 - February 13, 2013) there were 631 Help Wanted OnLine® (HWOL) ads posted for internships, according to data from The Conference Board. This is an increase of 82 ads from the previous reporting period. Compared to the same time period a year ago, this reflects an increase of 139 ads. In addition, the graph below reflects monthly trends of new internship ads posted through February 13, 2013.
