

Snapshot of Ohio Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

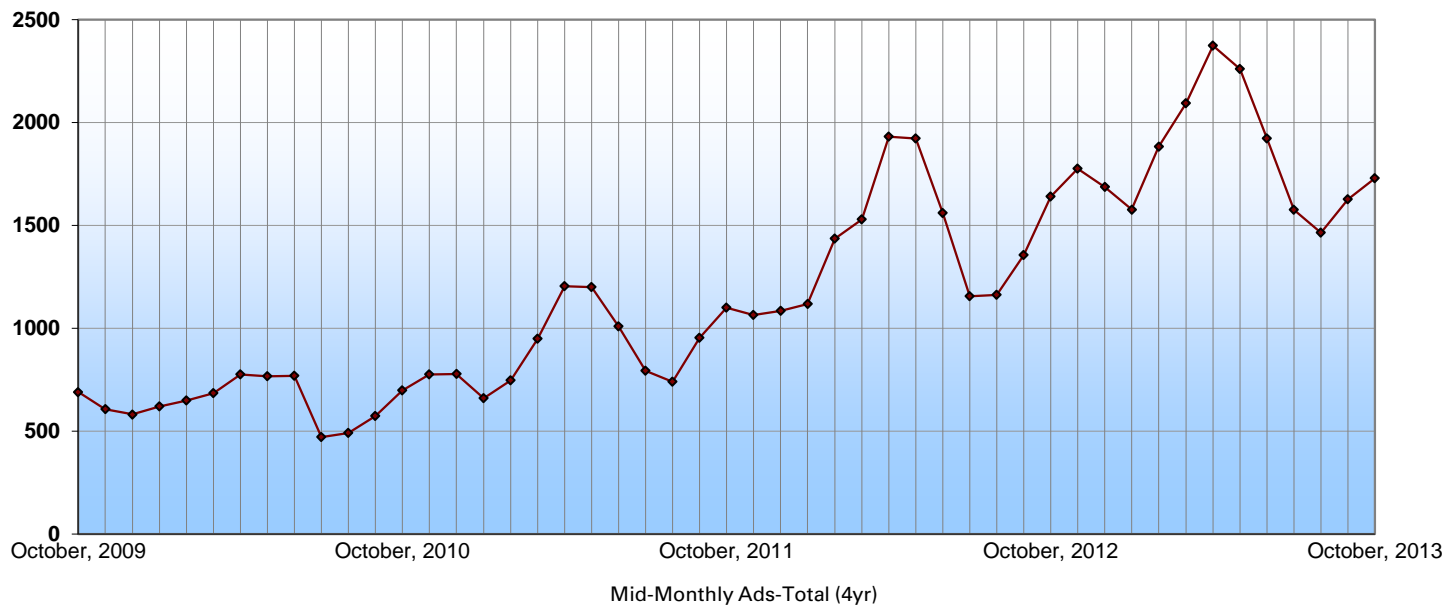

Summary

For the last 30-day Conference Board reporting period (September 14, 2013 - October 13, 2013) there were 1,729 Help Wanted OnLine® (HWOL) ads posted for internships, according to data from The Conference Board. This is an increase of 101 ads from the previous reporting period. Compared to the same time period a year ago, this reflects an increase of 88 ads. In addition, the graph below reflects monthly trends of new internship ads posted through October 13, 2013.
