

Snapshot of Ohio Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

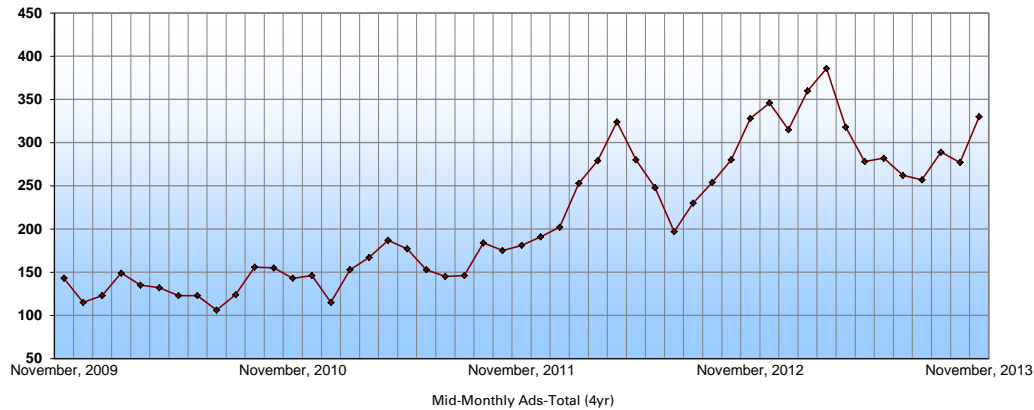

Summary

For the last 30-day Conference Board reporting period (October 14, 2013 - November 13, 2013) there were 330 Help Wanted OnLine® (HWOL) ads posted for internships, according to data from The Conference Board. This is an increase of 53 ads from the previous reporting period. Compared to the same time period a year ago, this reflects an increase of 2 ads. In addition, the graph below reflects monthly trends of new internship ads posted through November 13, 2013.
