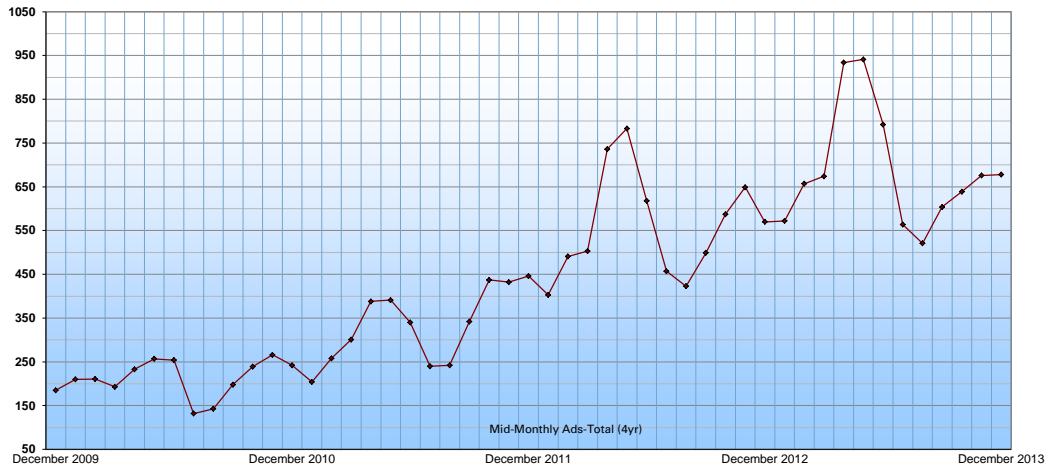


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Cleveland-Northeast JobsOhio Network

December 2013 Snapshot of 678 Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

More than 670 internship openings were posted online from November 14, 2013, through December 13, 2013, for Cleveland and northeast Ohio. This was an increase of two ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 108 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows new internship ads posted each month in this area from December 2009 through December 2013.
