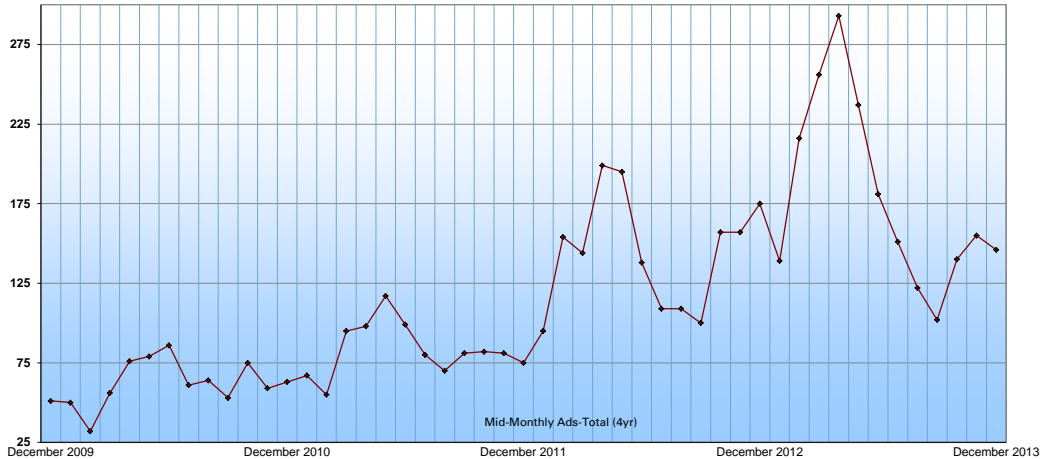


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Dayton-West JobsOhio Network

December 2013 Snapshot of 146 Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

More than 140 internship openings were posted online from November 14, 2013, through December 13, 2013, for Dayton and west Ohio. This was a decrease of nine ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 29 ads compared to the same time period a year ago.
