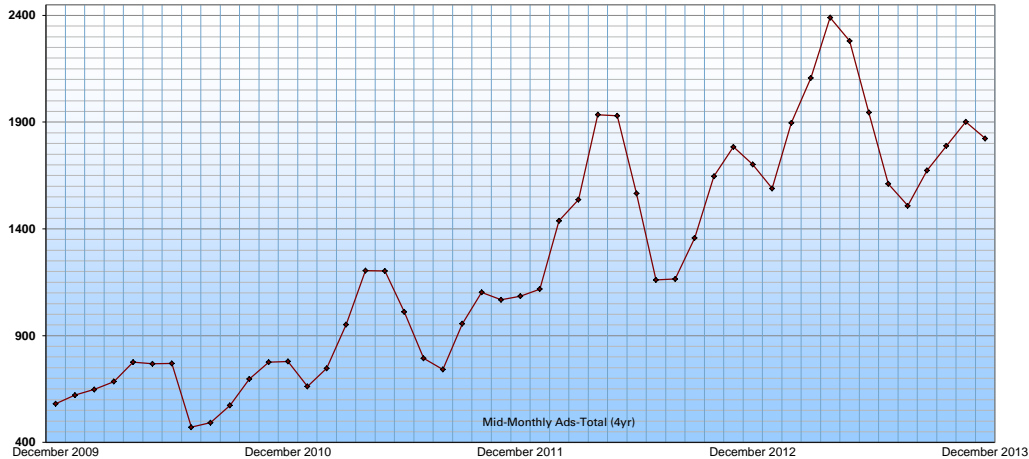

December 2013 Snapshot of 1,823 Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

More than 1,800 internship openings were posted online from November 14, 2013, through December 13, 2013, for Ohio. This was a decrease of 79 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 121 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows new internship ads posted each month in this area from December 2009 through December 2013.
