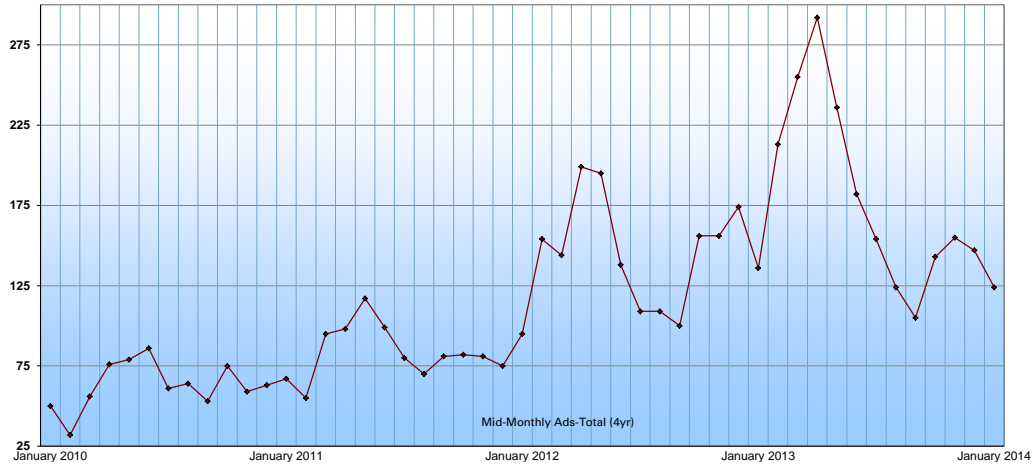


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Dayton-West JobsOhio Network

January 2014 Snapshot of 124 Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

More than 120 internship openings were posted online from December 14, 2013, through January 13, 2014, for Dayton and west Ohio. This was a decrease of 23 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 12 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows new internship ads posted each month in this area from January 2010 through January 2014.
