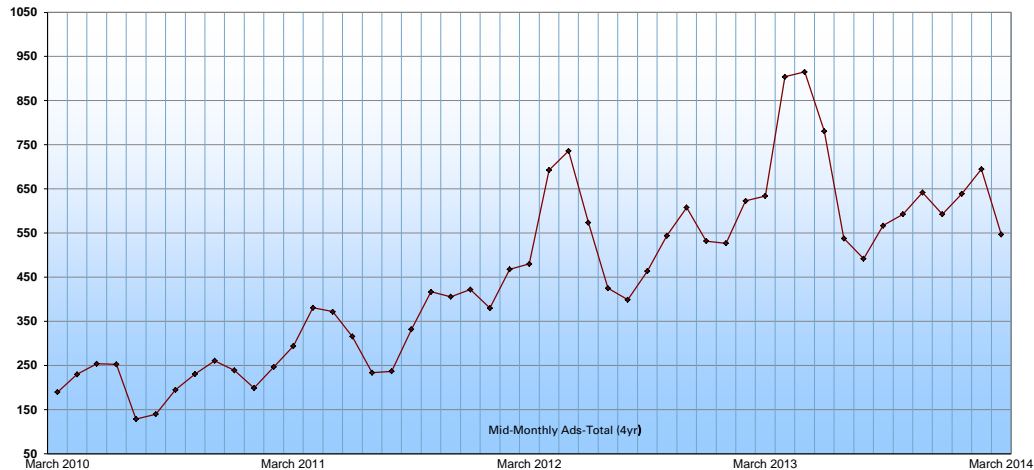


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Cleveland-Northeast JobsOhio Network

March 2014 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

There were 547 internship openings posted online from February 14, 2014, through March 13, 2014, for Cleveland and northeast Ohio. This was a decrease of 148 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 87 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the past several years.
