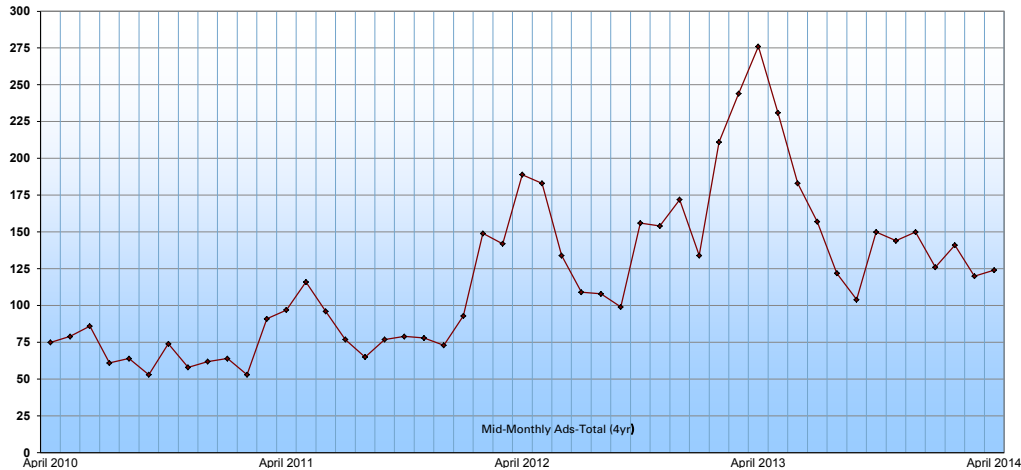


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Dayton-West JobsOhio Network

April 2014 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 119 internship openings were posted online from March 14, 2014, through April 13, 2014, for Dayton and west Ohio. This was an increase of 4 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 152 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
