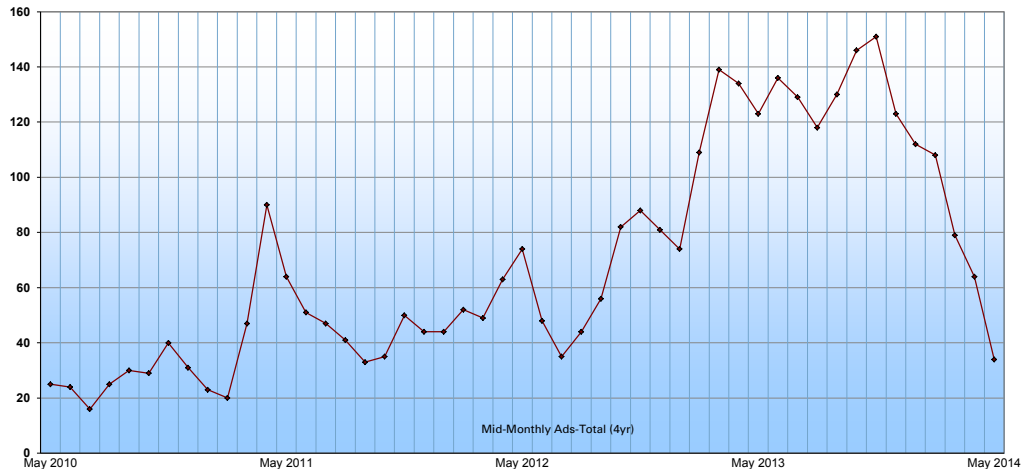


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Toledo-Northwest JobsOhio Network

May 2014 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 34 internship openings were posted online from April 14, 2014, through May 13, 2014, for Toledo and northwest Ohio. This was a decrease of 30 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 89 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
