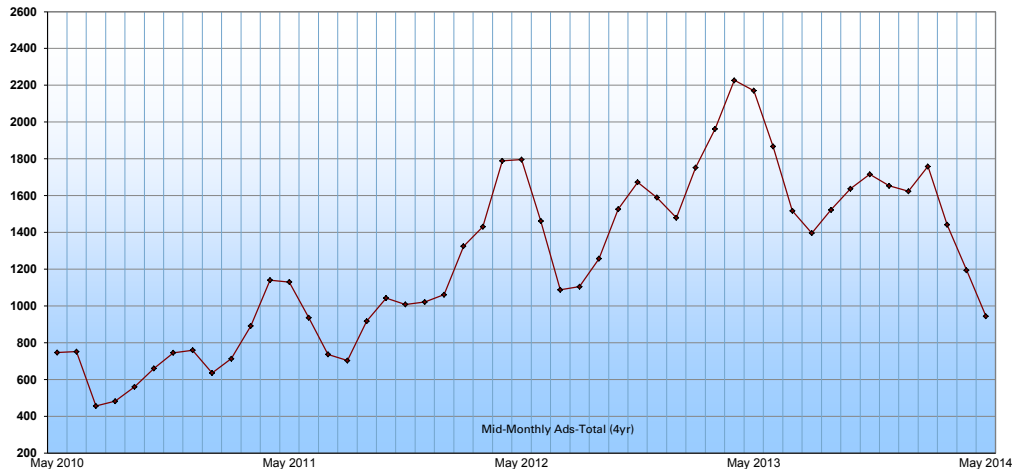


May 2014 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 945 internship openings were posted online from April 14, 2014, through May 13, 2014, for Ohio. This was a decrease of 249 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 1,226 ads compared to the same time period a year ago.
