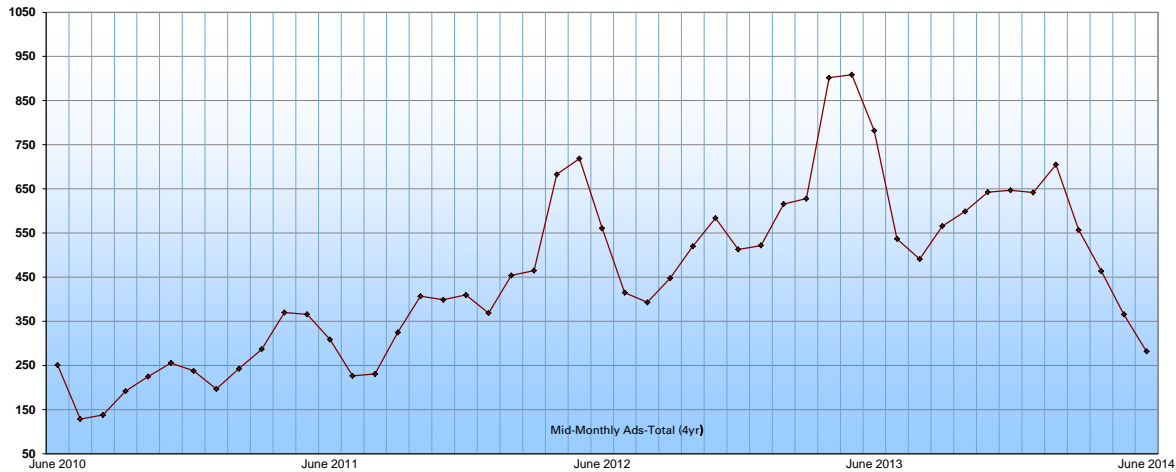


## Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Cleveland-Northeast JobsOhio Network

### June 2014 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 282 internship openings were posted online from May 14, 2014, through June 13, 2014, for Cleveland and northeast Ohio. This was a decrease of 84 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 500 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the past several years.
