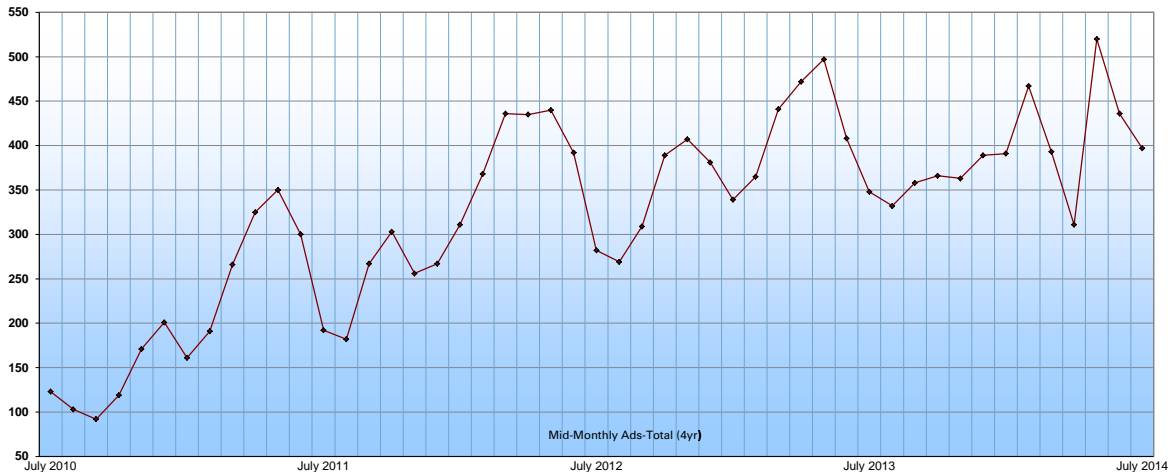


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Columbus-Central JobsOhio Network

July 2014 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 397 internship ads were posted online from June 14, 2014, through July 13, 2014, for Columbus and central Ohio. This was a decrease of 39 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 49 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
