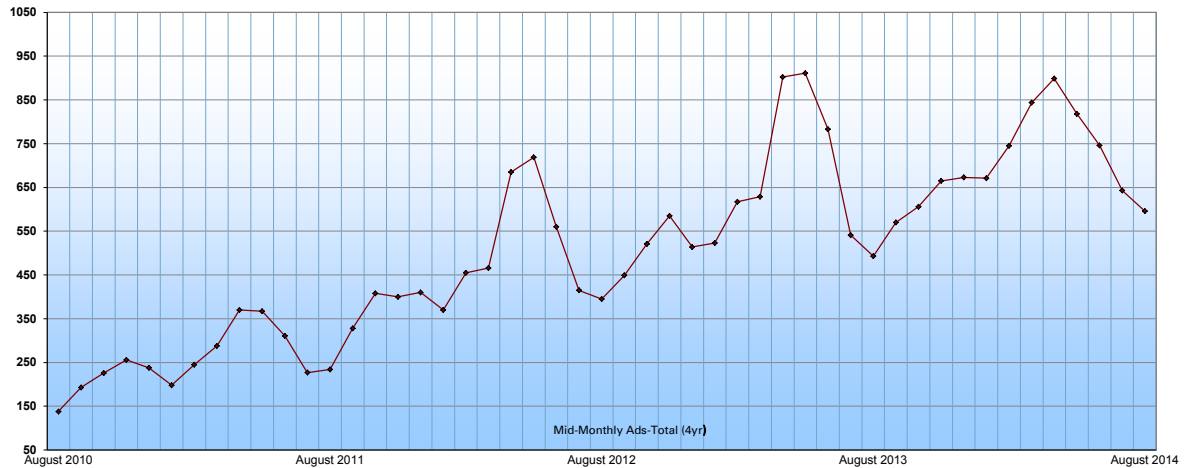


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Northeast JobsOhio Network

August 2014 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 596 internship ads were posted online from July 14, 2014, through August 13, 2014, for northeast Ohio. This was a decrease of 47 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 103 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the past several years.
