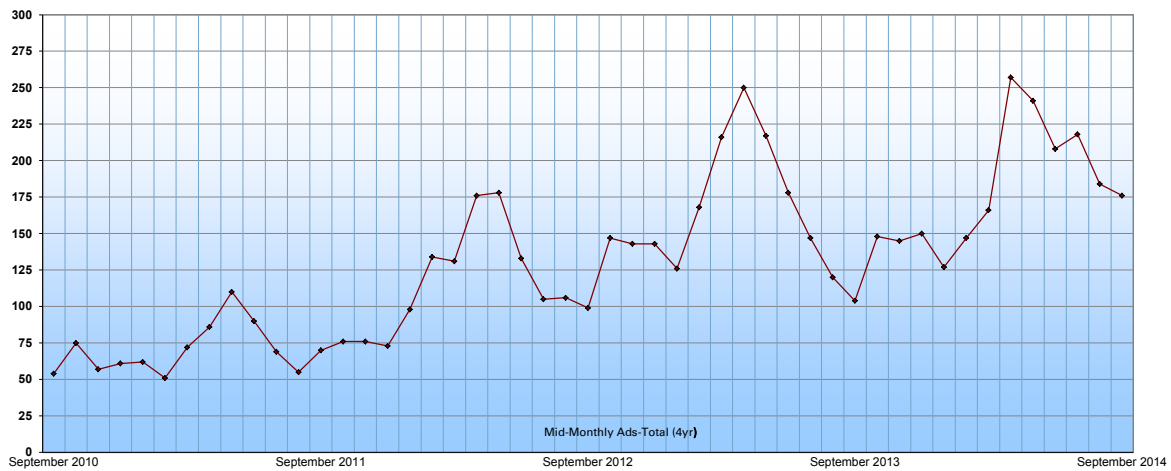


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the West JobsOhio Network

September 2014 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 176 internship ads were posted online from August 14, 2014, through September 13, 2014, for west Ohio. This was a decrease of eight ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 72 ads compared to the same time period a year ago.
