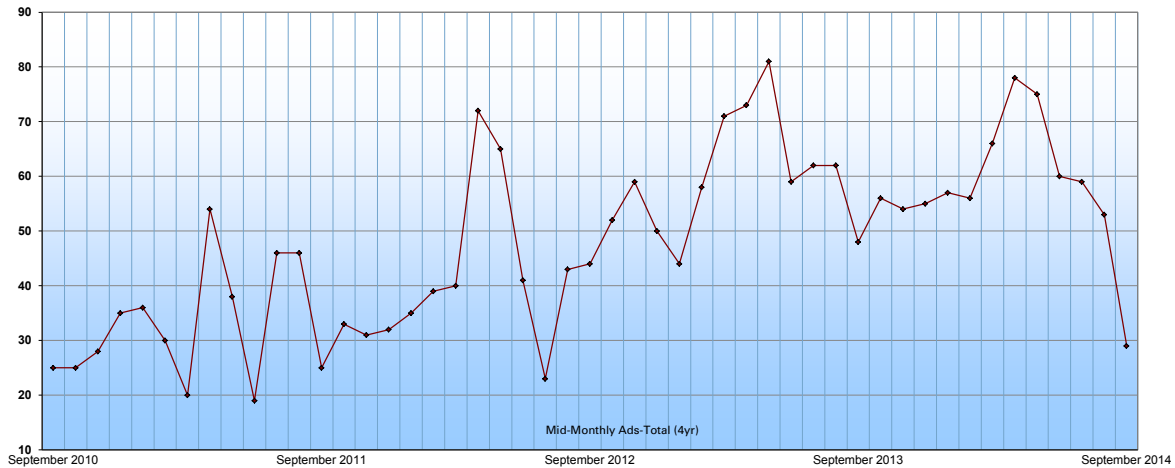


## Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Southeast JobsOhio Network

### September 2014 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 29 internship ads were posted online from August 14, 2014, through September 13, 2014, for southeast Ohio. This was a decrease of 24 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 19 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
