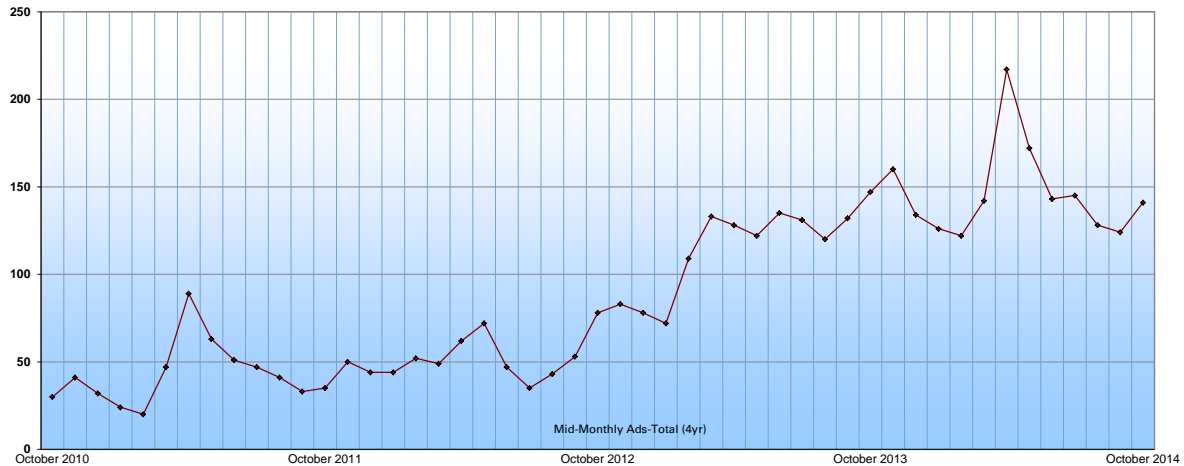


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Northwest JobsOhio Network

October 2014 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 141 internship ads were posted online from September 14, 2014, through October 13, 2014, for northwest Ohio. There was an increase of 17 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of six ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
