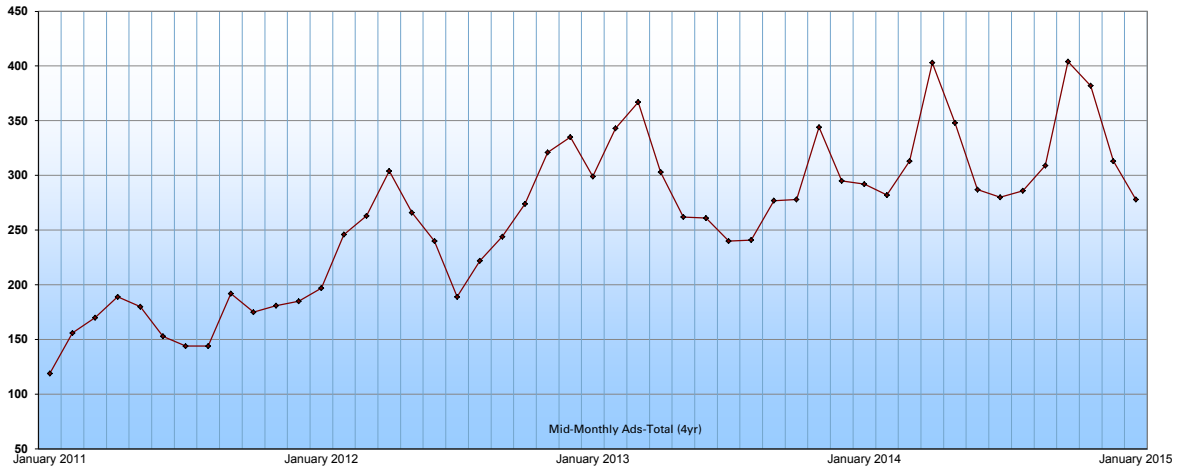


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Southwest JobsOhio Network

January 2015 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 278 internship ads were posted online from December 14, 2014, through January 13, 2015, for southwest Ohio. This was a decrease of 35 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 14 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
