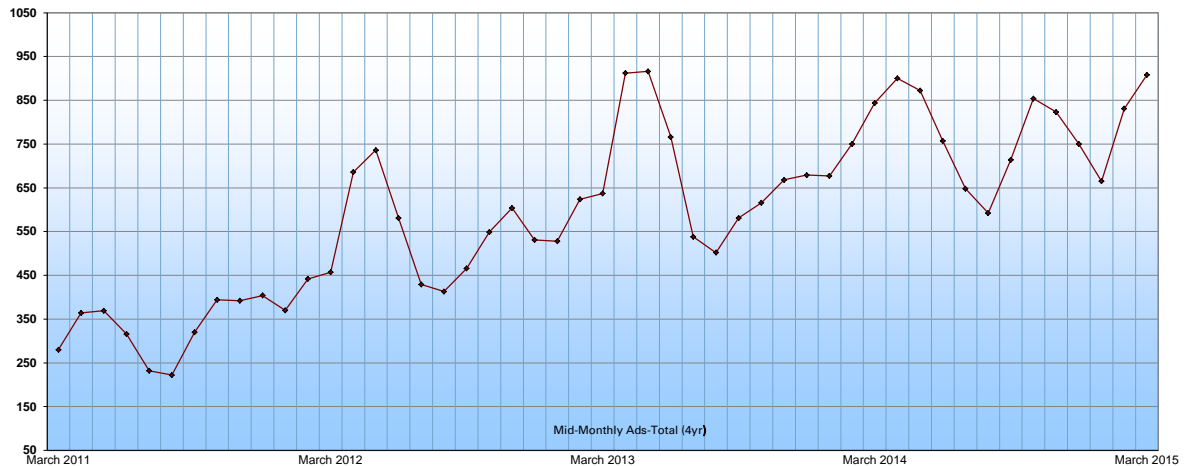


## Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Northeast JobsOhio Network

### March 2015 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 908 internship ads were posted online from February 14, 2015, through March 13, 2015, for northeast Ohio. This was an increase of 77 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 64 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the past several years.
