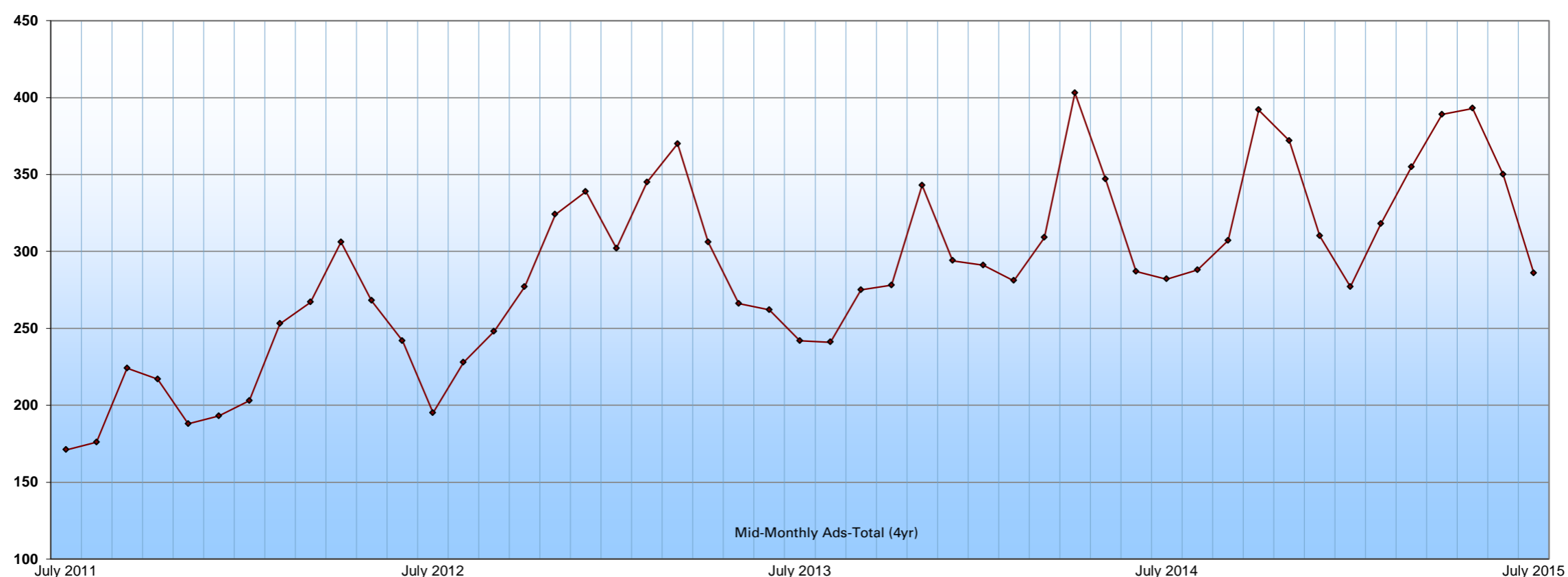


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Southwest JobsOhio Network

July 2015 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 286 internship ads were posted online from June 14, 2015, through July 13, 2015, for southwest Ohio. This was a decrease of 64 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of four ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
