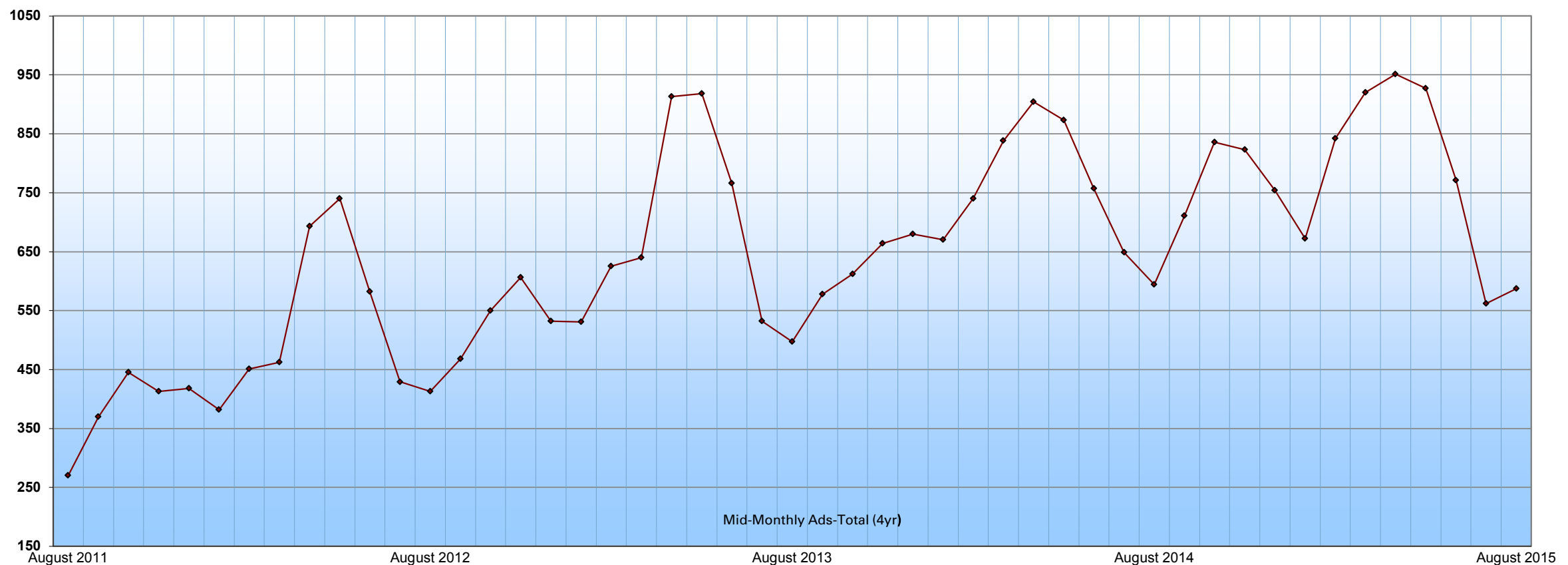


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Northeast JobsOhio Network

August 2015 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 587 internship ads were posted online from July 14, 2015, through August 13, 2015, for northeast Ohio. This was an increase of 25 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 7 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the past several years.
