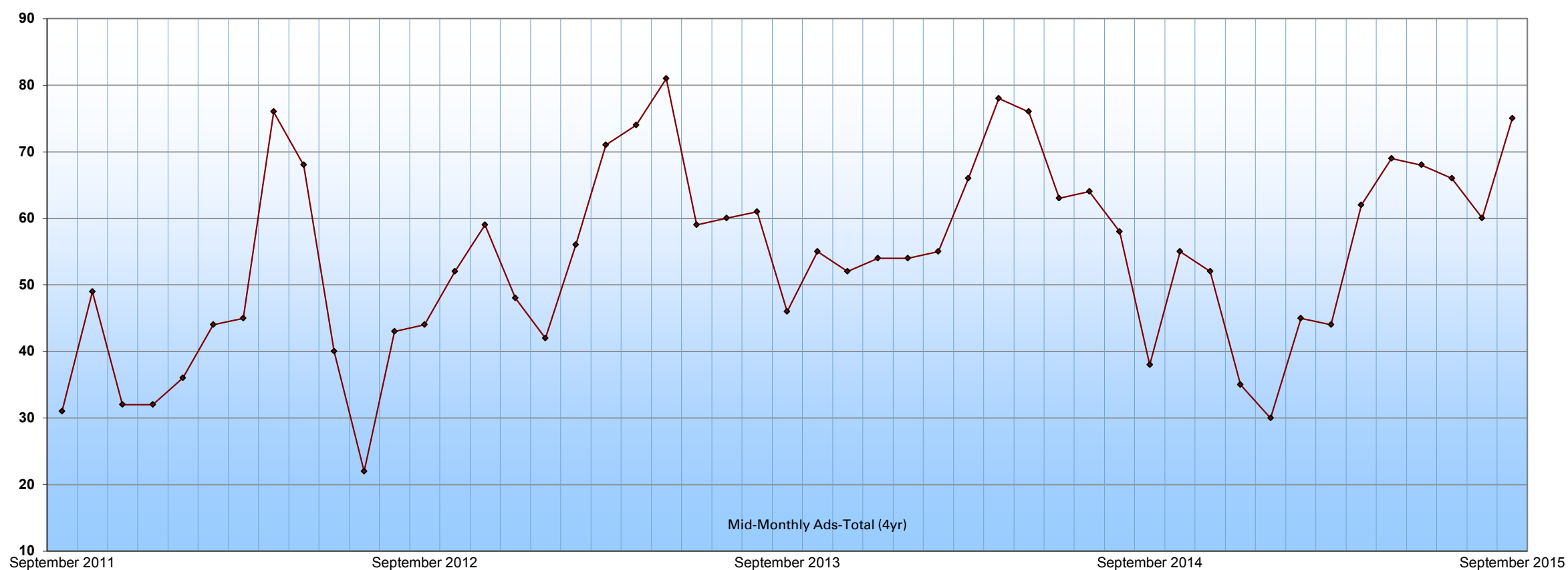


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Southeast JobsOhio Network

September 2015 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 75 internship ads were posted online from August 14, 2015, through September 13, 2015, for southeast Ohio. This was an increase of 15 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 37 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
