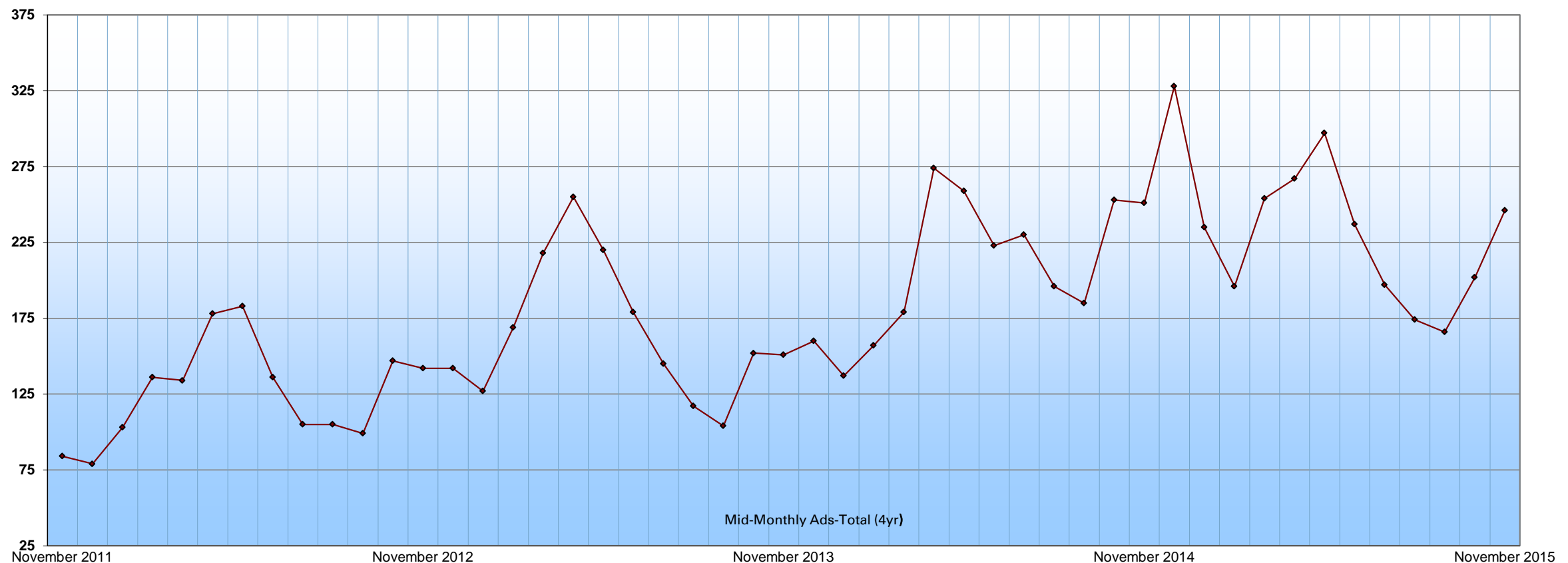


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the West JobsOhio Network

November 2015 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 246 internship ads were posted online from October 14, 2015, through November 13, 2015, for west Ohio. This was an increase of 44 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of five ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
