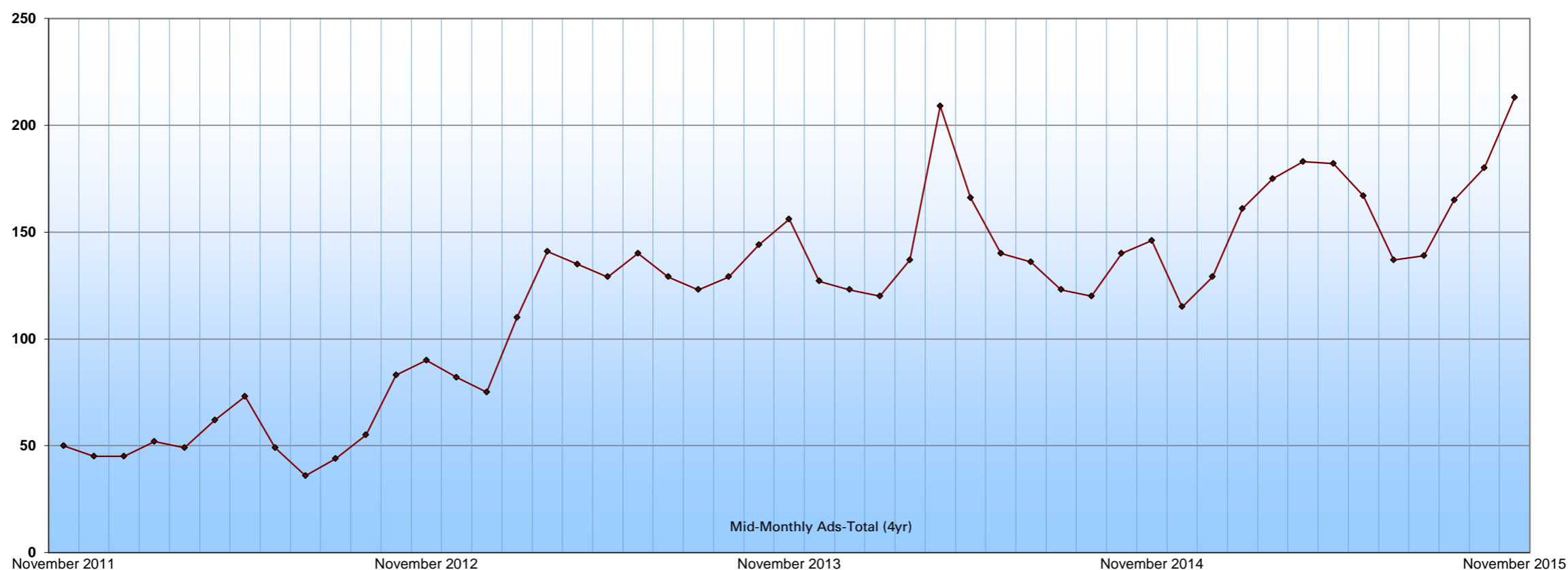


## Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Northwest JobsOhio Network

### November 2015 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 213 internship ads were posted online from October 14, 2015, through November 13, 2015, for northwest Ohio. This was an increase of 33 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 67 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
