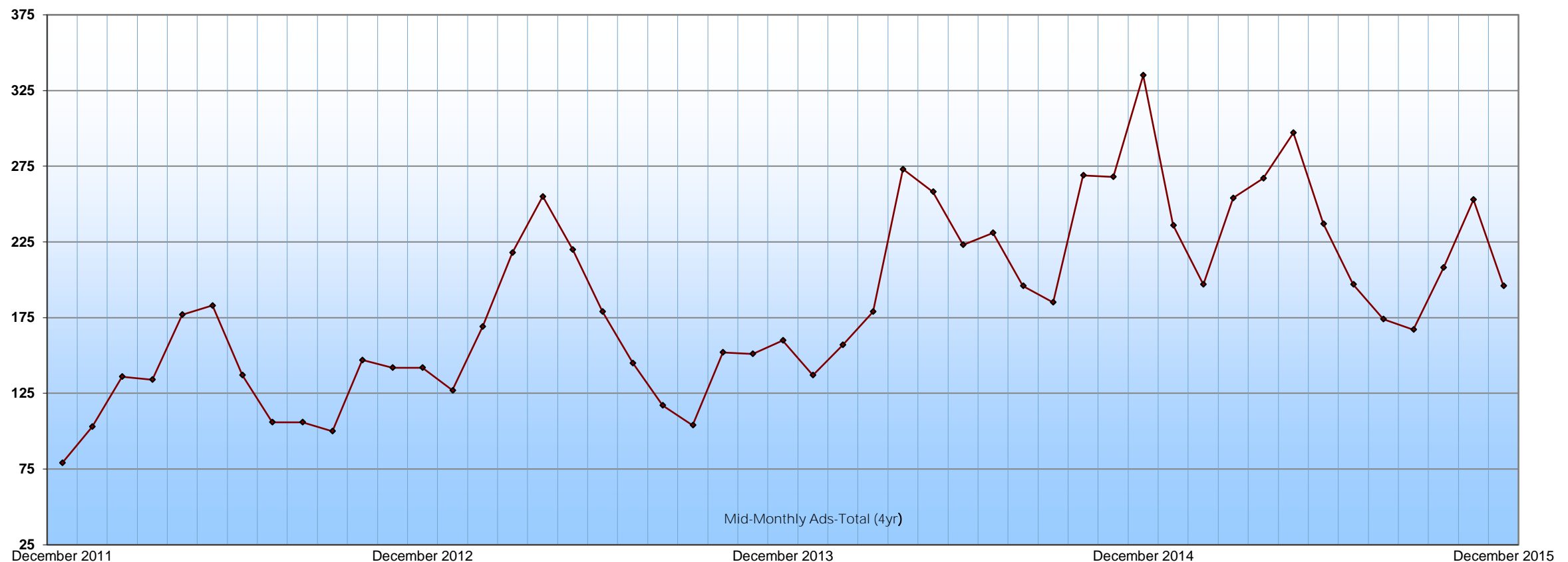


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the West JobsOhio Network

December 2015 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 196 internship ads were posted online from November 14, 2015, through December 13, 2015, for west Ohio. This was a decrease of 57 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 139 ads compared to the same time period a year ago.
