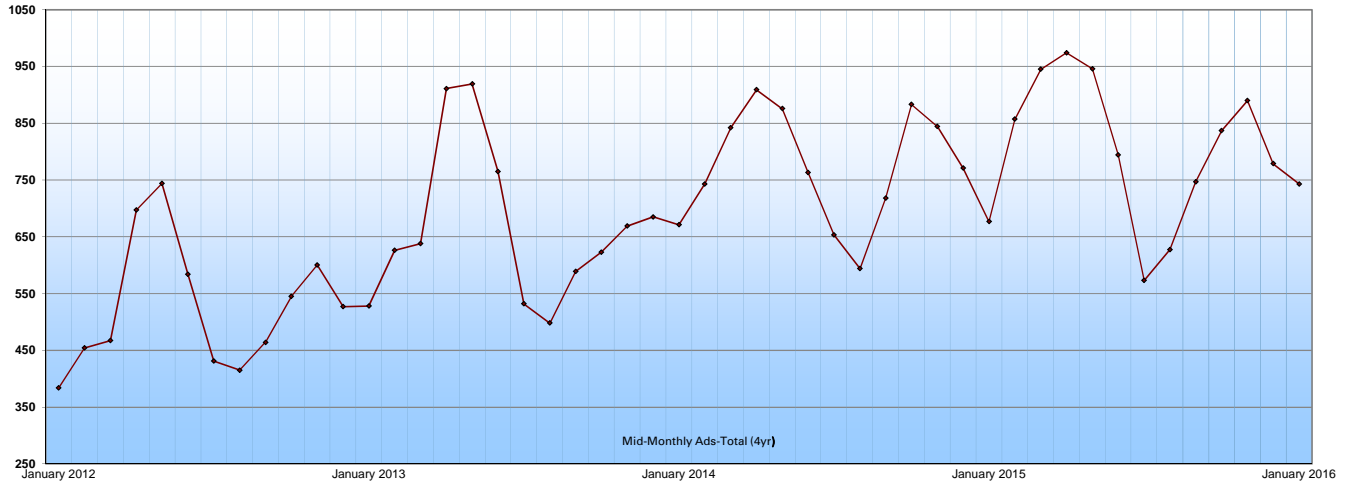


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Northeast JobsOhio Network

January 2016 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 743 internship ads were posted online from December 14, 2015, through January 13, 2016, for northeast Ohio. This was a decrease of .3 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 66 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the past several years.
