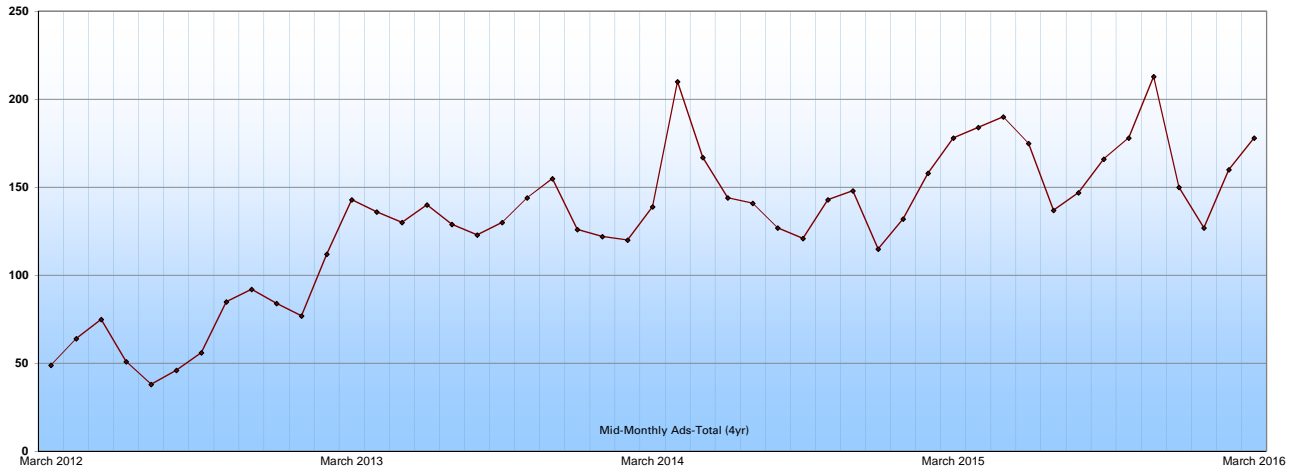


## Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Northwest JobsOhio Network

### March 2016 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 178 internship ads were posted online from February 14, 2016, through March 13, 2016, for northwest Ohio. This was an increase of 18 ads from the previous reporting period and no change compared to the same time period a year ago.
