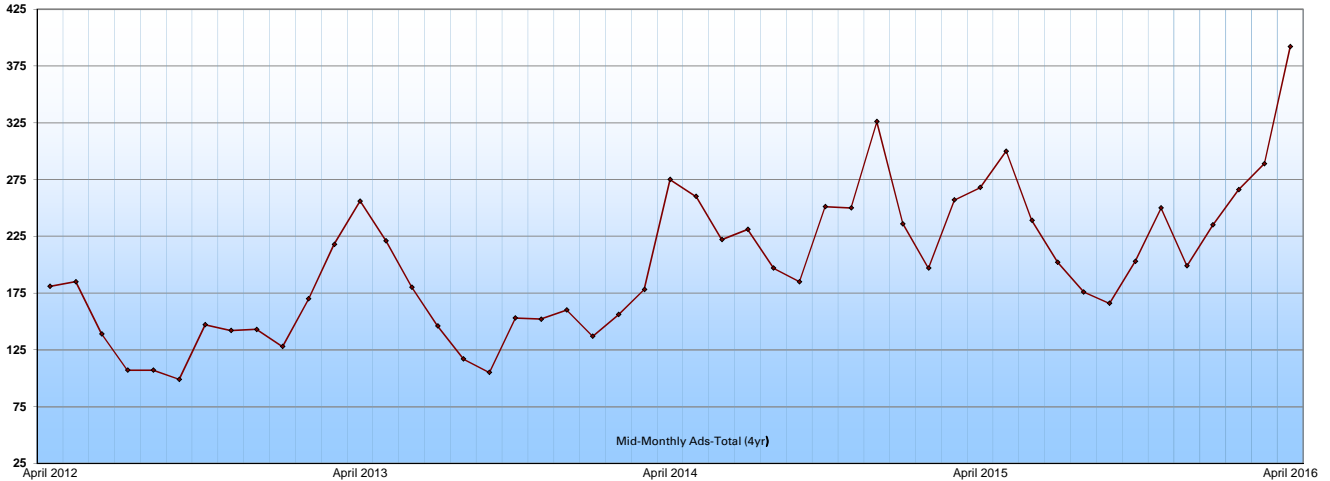


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the West JobsOhio Network

April 2016 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 392 internship ads were posted online from March 14, 2016, through April 13, 2016, for west Ohio. This was an increase of 103 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 124 ads compared to the same time period a year ago.
