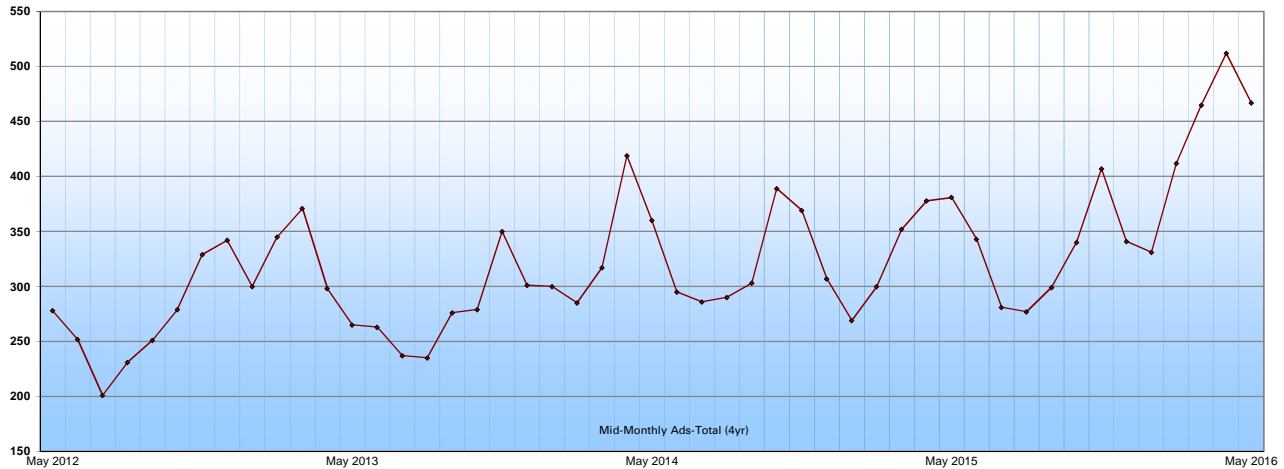


## Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Southwest JobsOhio Network

### May 2016 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 467 internship ads were posted online from April 14, 2016, through May 13, 2016, for southwest Ohio. This was a decrease of 45 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 86 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
