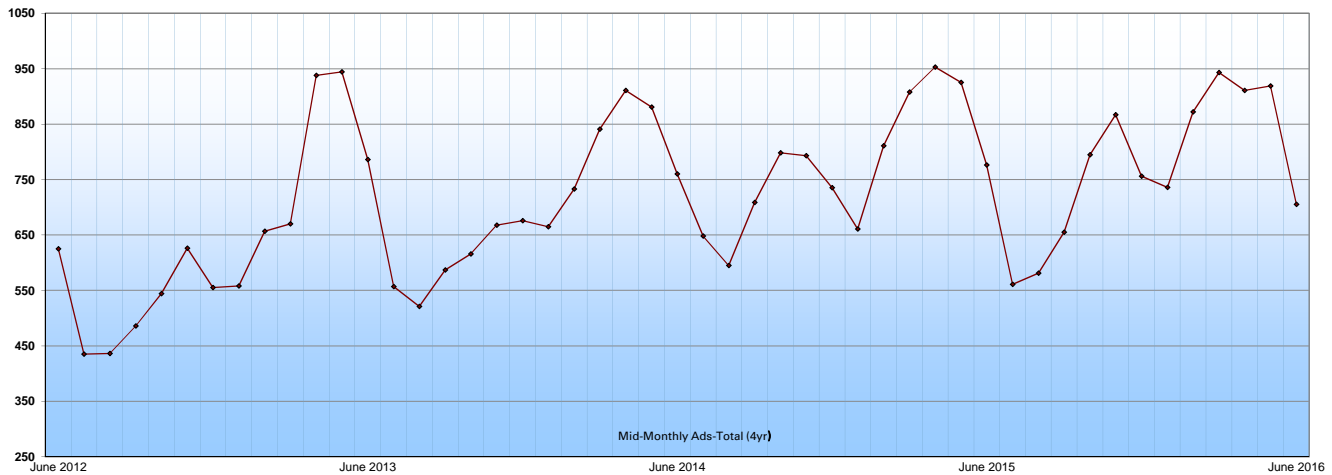


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Northeast JobsOhio Network

June 2016 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 705 internship ads were posted online from May 14, 2016, through June 13, 2016, for northeast Ohio. This was a decrease of 214 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 71 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the past several years.
