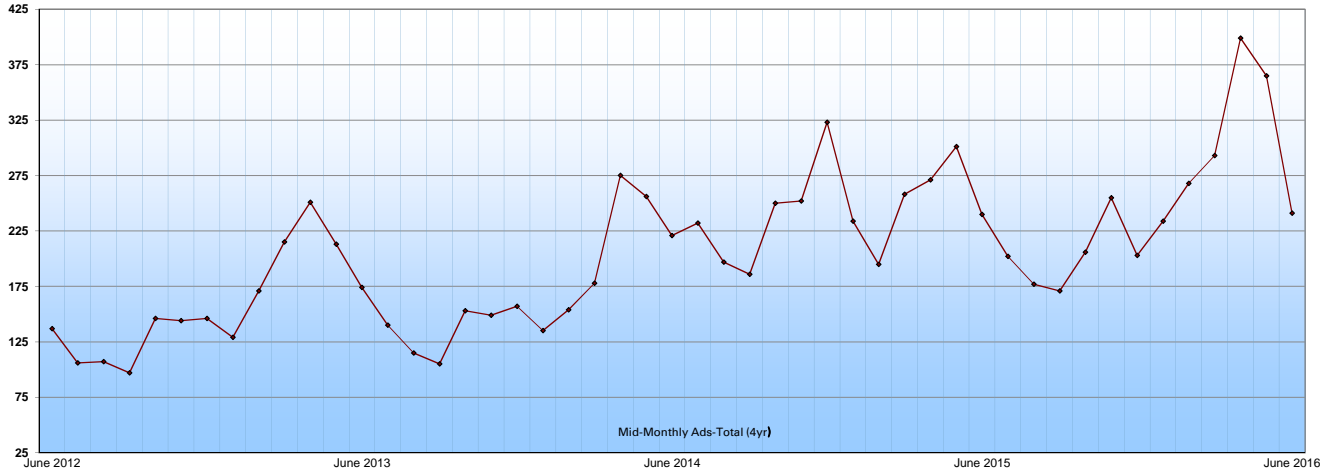


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the West JobsOhio Network

June 2016 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 241 internship ads were posted online from May 14, 2016, through June 13, 2016, for west Ohio. This was a decrease of 124 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of one ad compared to the same time period a year ago.
