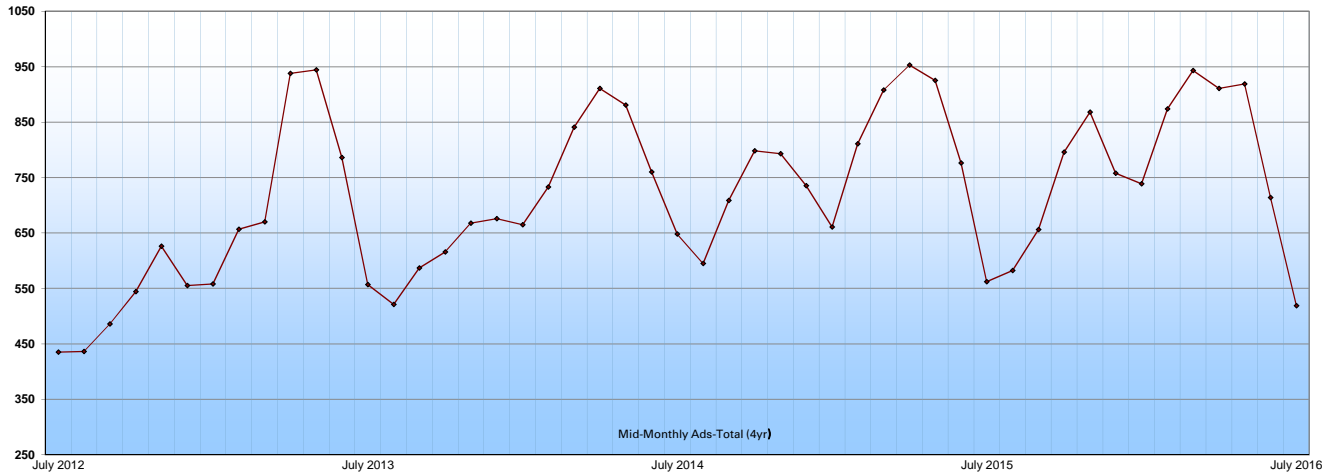


## Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Northeast JobsOhio Network

### July 2016 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 519 internship ads were posted online from June 14, 2016, through July 13, 2016, for northeast Ohio. This was a decrease of 195 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 43 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the past several years.
