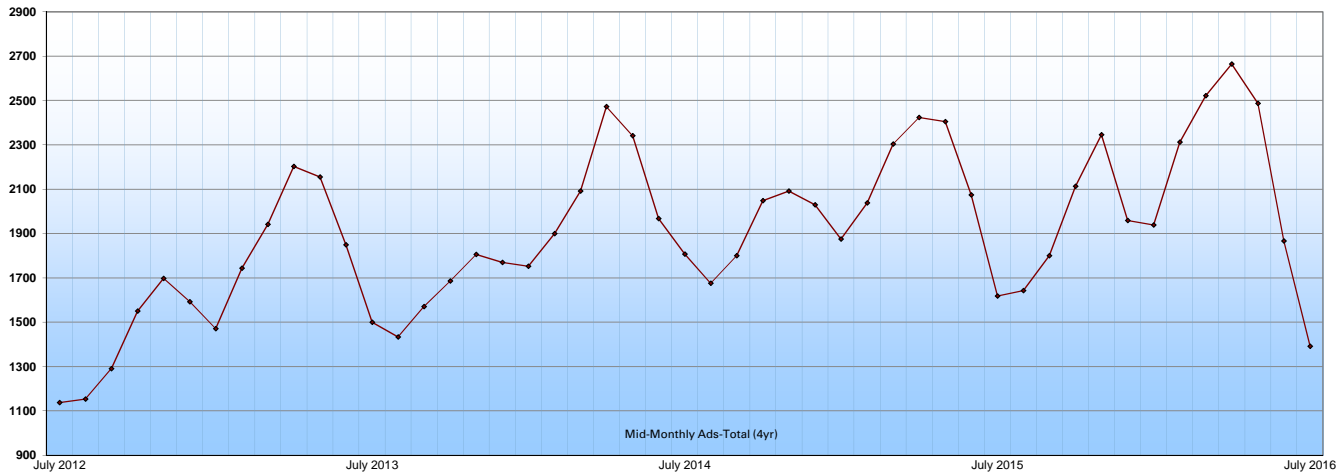

July 2016 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 1,391 internship ads were posted online from June 14, 2016, through July 13, 2016, for Ohio. This was a decrease of 476 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 227 ads compared to the same time period a year ago.
