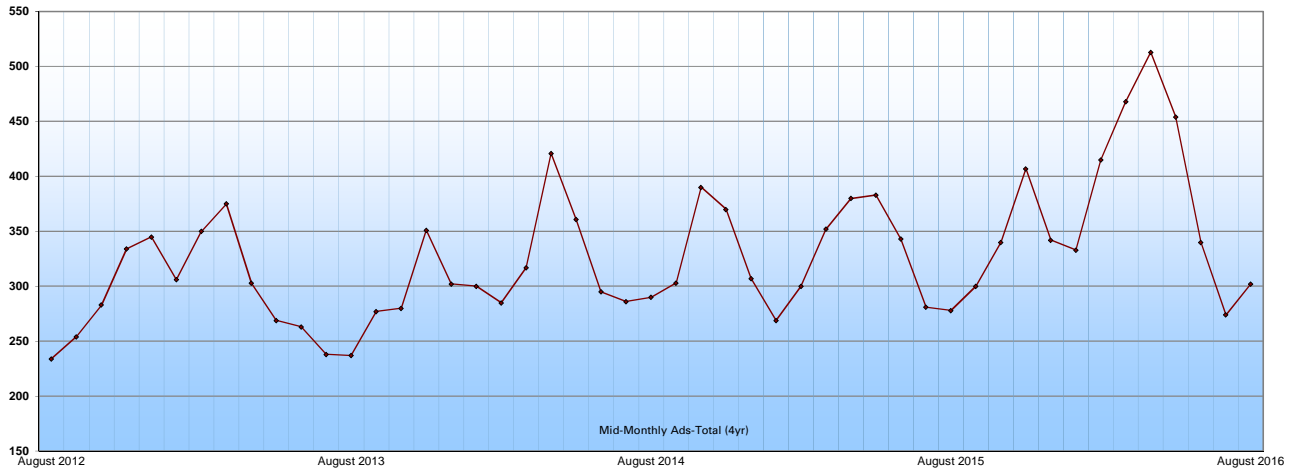


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Southwest JobsOhio Network

August 2016 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 302 internship ads were posted online from July 14, 2016, through August 13, 2016, for southwest Ohio. This was an increase of 28 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 24 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
