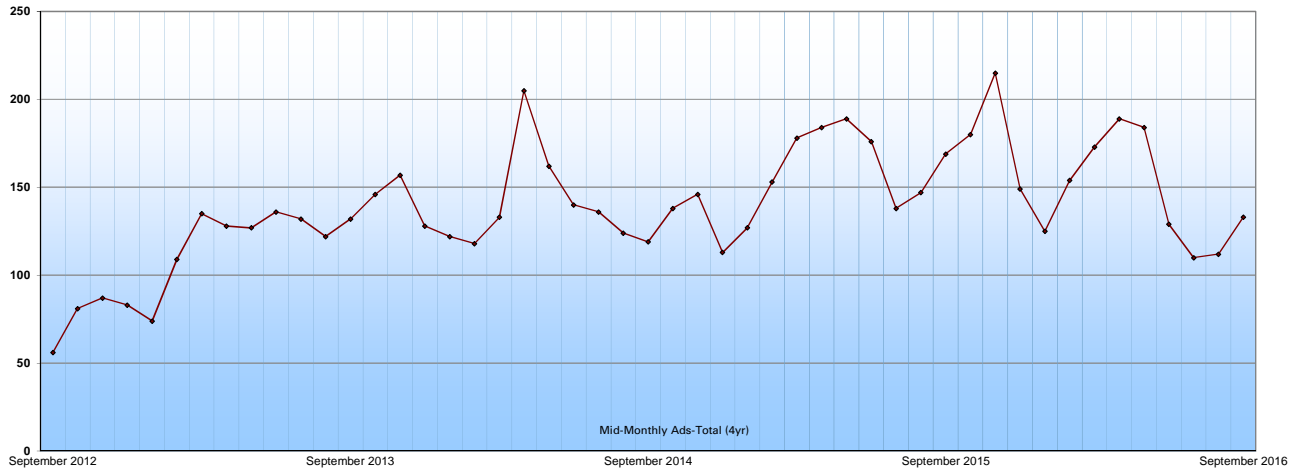


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Northwest JobsOhio Network

September 2016 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 133 internship ads were posted online from August 14, 2016, through September 13, 2016, for northwest Ohio. This was an increase of 21 ad from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 36 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
