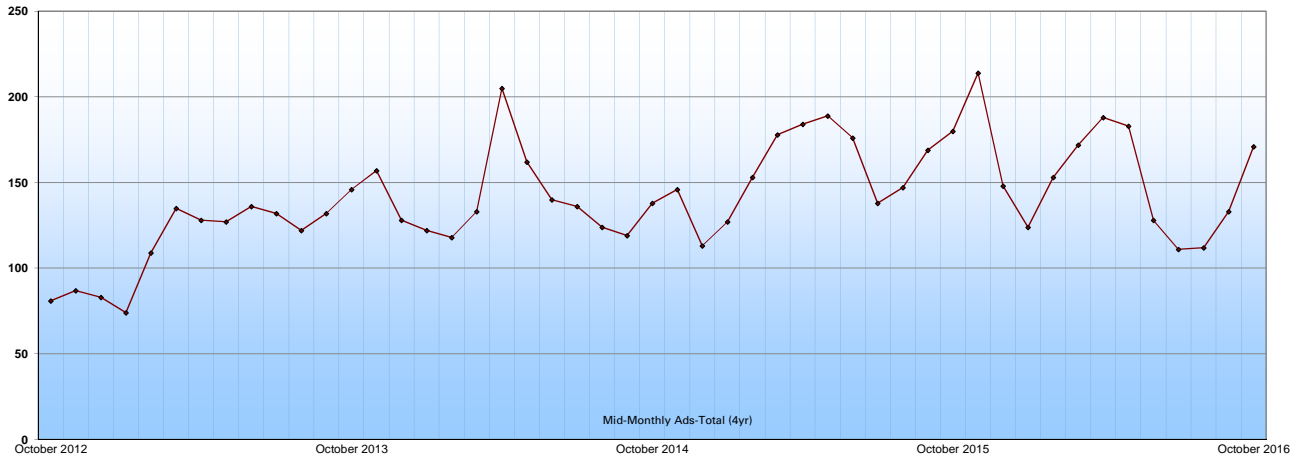


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Northwest JobsOhio Network

October 2016 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 171 internship ads were posted online from September 14, 2016, through October 13, 2016, for northwest Ohio. This was an increase of 38 ad from the previous reporting period and a decrease of nine ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
